

Berita Harian (20 May, p3), "Grandmother is only place for child with additional needs to depend on"

Born premature at 34 weeks, Rayyan Sukri has never experienced the love of a mother or a father his entire life.

His mother was heavily involved with drugs and failed to show up at a urine drug screening. She was apprehended by officers from the Central Narcotics Bureau after delivering Rayyan at the hospital.

His father has also been jailed due to involvement in drugs. Both parents have been in and out of jail.

Mdm Sakinah, Rayyan's grandmother, had no other choice but to bring Rayyan home from the hospital following his birth. From that moment, Mdm Sakinah has been Rayyan's main caregiver. The child will be turning five years old this November.

When Rayyan turned two years old, Mdm Sakinah, 65, bought him a baby walker.

"(In my heart, I said) Why does the child not know how to move, he is often still", lamented the grandmother to 16 grandchildren, and mother of six children.

When she brought Rayyan to a health check-up, the family was informed that Rayyan had cerebral palsy and global developmental delay.

"My son (Rayyan's uncle) asked the doctor, who explained that this was a side effect of high drugs consumption. His brain was also affected," said Mdm Sakinah, who also said that Rayyan's mother continued to consume drugs while pregnant with him.

Till today, Rayyan had to frequent Singapore General Hospital and KK Women's and Children's Hospital monthly for eyes and ears screening, and to track his development.

All these is done by Mdm Sakinah herself, who travels via bus and train from her one-room rental flat in Toa Payoh. It gets a bit more difficult each day, as Rayyan continues to grow and put on weight, while Mdm Sakinah, who was petite in size, continues to age.

Thankfully, a special stroller was gifted to Rayyan from AWWA, a social service agency, allowing Mdm Sakinah to shuttle Rayyan from one place to another with greater ease. Rayyan attends early intervention sessions at the AWWA Early Intervention Centre (EIC) @ Kim Keat three times a week.

"I have to be strong. Sometimes, I have to thicken my skin and ask for help from other commuters to lift Rayyan's stroller up and down the bus," said Mdm Sakinah, who added that often times, bus drivers are unable to recognise that Rayyan's stroller was a stroller meant for a child with additional needs.

Taking care of Rayyan is no easy feat, and his needs are increasing as he grows older. The team at AWWA, made up of therapists, teachers and social workers sometimes visit Rayyan and Mdm Sakinah at home. They showed her ways of showering Rayyan, so that it was easier for her.

Head teacher at AWWA EIC @ Kim Keat, Ms Fazlinda Mohd Affendi Nasir, shared, "The first time Rayyan joined us, he did not have a lot of awareness, and was unable to do things that a typically developing child could do, such as sitting, standing or grasping objects. This was

why we equipped his grandmother with assistive technology such as the stroller, an activity chair and a bath chair for Rayyan.”

Today, Rayyan has displayed improvements in his non-verbal response when someone is communicating with him. He has attained better head control and is able to maintain eye contact when others are interacting with him, added Ms Fazlinda.

Rayyan’s social worker, Ms Nurharyati Mohammed Sa’at shared, “As a social worker, I often check in on Mdm Sakinah’s well-being, as she often shares about difficulties faced in caring for Rayyan, and in shuttling him to and from hospitals. This way, there is someone for her to confide in, as she cares for Rayyan for 24 hours a day.”

She also helped Mdm Sakinah, who is not working, attain additional assistance, in the form of diapers and milk formula.

When asked about her Hari Raya celebrations, Mdm Sakinah answered, “Hari Raya or not, it is it the same for me.”

She said that there was not much preparations that she could do since she started taking care of Rayyan, as the demands of a child with additional needs was different. Her other children would send over Hari Raya dishes to her home, and visit her during the festivities.

“What else can I do? He is my grandson. It is not as if I will disown him when I heard that he has cerebral palsy. If he could speak, perhaps he would say that he does not want to be this way. I accept this gift of my grandson,” said Mdm Sakinah.

“Sometimes, I do cry. I will tell Rayyan, - It’s okay, Rayyan. I will be patient. You must pray that I am granted health and strength to take care of you. If I am no longer around, I do not know who else can take care of you,” she added, her eyes glistening with tears.

Hanya nenek tempat bergantung anak istimewa

Ibu bapa dipenjarakan sejak kelahirannya dengan palsi serebrum, pembanguan lewat

DILAHIRKAN premata pada 26 minggu, Rayyan Sidiq tidak pernah memera kanti anyang seorang ibu mahupun ayah sepanjang dia membesar.

Ibunya terjatuh dalam karambah dadah dan tidak mampuh bagi urus kemung dan ditangkapi pegawai Bara Narkotik Pasat (CNB) setelah melakukan Rayyan di hospital.

Bapanya pula sudah di dalam penjara, juga kerana dadah. Mereka berdua-lelaki kakar masuk penjara. Terpaksa lah memakainya, Cik Sakinah Hassan, mengasah Rayyan dan hospital dan membezakannya pulang. Sejak itu, beliau penjaga utama Rayyan, yang akan bertam lima tahun November ini.

Ketika Rayyan berusia dua tahun, Cik Sakinah, 65 tahun, membezakannya walikan bayi.

"(Dalam hati saya) 'kenapa budak ini dah dua tahun tapi tak tahu bergesak, diam sahaja', " cerita nenek 16 cucu dan omni anak itu.

Apabila membezakan Rayyan bagi pemeriksaan doktor, berdebat membezakan pendapat dia mengenai pal-

si serebrum dan kolowatan pembelajaran global (GDCI).

"Anak saya (pale cik Rayyan) hanya doktor dan doktor kaku ia adalah kolowatan pembelajaran dadah yang terbelah banyak. Otaknya pun rosak," ujar Cik Sakinah, sambil beritahu ibu Rayyan terus mengahap dadah ketika lahir.

Hingga kini Rayyan pergi ke Hospital Besar Singapura (SGH) dan Hospital Wanita dan Kanak-kanak KK (KNI) setiap bulan bagi pemeriksaan doktor, mata, telinga dan perubatan lainnya.

Sementara dibelakan Cik Sakinah seorang dia, tanpa anak lain dan MHF dari dia sewa satu biliknya di Tox Payoh. Semakin hari semakin nakar baginya, Rayyan yang membesar bertumbuh berat sedangkan Cik Sakinah, yang kucif dan kurus, kian merangkat tua.

Moge ada kereta seorang kluas yang diberi agensi perkhidmatan sosial AWWA, yang membolehkan neneknya itu membezakan Rayyan ke mana-mana. Rayyan menghadiri Pusat Intervensi Awal (EIC) AWWA di Kim Seng tiga kali seminggu.

"Nekad sahaja. Kadang saya buat mesuk selamba dan mata to-

long perancang lain angkat kereta seorang kakar dan masuk bus," kata Cik Sakinah, yang memarah ada pemerah bus tidak sadar kereta seorang itu bagi kanak-kanak berkeperluan khas.

Mengapa Rayyan juga tidak mudah dan keperluannya berdebat dengan mantapnya. Oleh itu, pasukan AWWA yang terdiri daripada pakar terapi, guru dan pakar psikologi mengasah Cik Sakinah, yang tinggal berdebat dengan Rayyan, untuk mengajarnya cara memandikan kanak-kanak itu.

Ditengah di AWWA EIC @ Kim Seng, ketua guru yang membezakan Rayyan, Cik Faridah Mohd Athirah/Nazir, beritahu: "Bila kali pertama Ray-

yan menyertai kami, dia tak mampuh kecekapan yang banyak, dia pun tak dapat melakukan perkara yang dapat dilakukan kanak-kanak biasa, misalnya duduk, berdiri, mengagahkan sesuatu.

"Ibu sebabnya kami membezakan neneknya tolakagi bantuan seperti kereta sorong, kurasi aktiviti dan juga kurasi makan bagi Rayyan."

Kini, Rayyan menunjukkan kemajuan seperti memberi respon bahasa verbal apabila orang bercakap kepadanya, mengawal kepalanya dengan lebih baik dan memandikan ke arah orang berteluran dengannya, tambah Cik Faridah.

Pekerja sosial yang membezakan Rayyan, Cik Nurharyati Mohamad

Sa'at, pula beritahu: "Sebagai pekerja sosial, saya juga selalu bertanyanya kluas Cik Sakinah kerana beliau sering mengadu tentang keperluan membezakan Rayyan ke hospital dan menjaganya.

"Sudah-tidaklah beliau ada tempat mengadu kerana beliau aja menjaga Rayyan 24 jam."

Bekas tarat membezakan Cik Sakinah, yang tidak bukaris, membezakan bantuan buruan tambahan dalam bentuk susu dan langgan bagi cacanya.

Ditanya tentang membezakan Aidilfitriya, Cik Sakinah menjawab: "Hari Raya tak Hari Raya, sama saja".

Sajak menjaga cacanya itu, tidak banyak dilakukannya kerana "jaga

anak istimewa, penanya lain", kata beliau. Anak-anaknya yang lain mengahap janda Hari Raya dan membezakannya setiap tahun.

"Apa nak buat, dia cucu saya. Tidaklah bisa disuger dia ada palsi serebrum saya nak buang dia kan? Agaklah kalau dia boleh bercakap, dia boleh, bukan Rayyan tak nak jadi macam ini". Kita terima sajadah, dia lon angarah," ujar Cik Sakinah.

"Kadang, saya moga juga. Saya cakap dengan Rayyan, 'tak apalah Rayyan, matak sabar, Rayyan dia-kon upaya membezakan ebat dan kerat jaga Rayyan."

"Kalau mesuk dah tutup mata tak tahu siapa lagi yang nak jaga Rayyan," tambah beliau, bergantung air mata.
